MESSAGE FROM THE CEO



2022 has been an extraordinary year throughout the world, but especially for Ukraine. Russia's invasion of Ukraine last February and the escalating atrocities against the civilian population and Ukraine's infrastructure have severely challenged the international order in 2022. The resultant destruction and disruption have profoundly impacted individuals, families, and businesses. However, the tech business sector's employees and their families have faced this devastation resolutely and with amazing bravery and determination to prevail against the odds.

During 2022 the invasion saw many of our Ukrainian team members (currently approximately 34% of total staff) working from bomb shelters, subway tunnels, and many other unexpected and challenging locations. Our people were initially in a high state of flux, facing disrupted working hours and changing physical locations, in addition to taking care of their own safety and well-being, as well as that of their immediate and extended families. As a response to the pandemic, in June 2020, Miratech committed to a fully remote working model for all employees. At the onset of the invasion and war, we fully extended this to a mobile work model as part of a business continuity strategy. More recently, the Russian military has launched direct attacks on Ukraine's power and water supplies. They have not only targeted the infrastructure necessary for work but also for living through the winter. This has had an impact across the country, so Miratech is working to provide housing and work facilities with power generation, heat, light, and water storage. But challenging times create heroes. Our facilities, services, and support team never thought they would be saving lives. Today, this team is working 24/7. They are performing miracles by sustaining hundreds of co-workers who now face living and working in a country suffering from these latest Russian war crimes.

Despite all the difficulties and uncertainties, we have achieved much as a team. I am so proud of the way that our team has pulled together and adapted to the changing circumstances. Your willingness to go above and beyond, as well as your ability to think creatively and embrace innovation, has been key to our continued success and growth. As we reflect on our achievements over the past year, we should all feel a sense of pride. Miratech's unwavering commitment to our Core Values and Mission has been integral to our success, and it has not gone unnoticed. Despite the unexpected challenges, we approached our CSR activities with agility and adaptability, and we are excited to share the results with you.

I. MIRAHELP | RELOCATION PROGRAM

February 2022

The Russian invasion of Ukraine in February 2022 made a significant impact on the lives of many people, including employees of Miratech located in Ukraine. Organizing a relocation program for Miratech's employees during this crisis has been crucial for several reasons:

Safety: The safety of employees is the top priority for Miratech. A relocation program helped ensure that employees are out of harm's way and are not in danger of being caught up in conflict.

Business continuity: A relocation program helped ensure that the company continued to operate effectively, even during the crisis. By relocating our employees to safer areas, the company could provide a continuation of service to its customers and maintain business operations.

Employee well-being: The stress and uncertainty of being in a conflict zone can have a significant impact on employees' mental and emotional well-being. A relocation program helped alleviate some of that stress and anxiety by providing a safe and secure environment.

Retention: Providing support to our employees during a crisis helps build loyalty and trust. We have actively demonstrated our commitment to our employees' well-being, which will also increase the likelihood that they will stay with the company long-term.



II. MIRAHELP | EMPLOYEES SUPPORT PROGRAM

March 2022

At Miratech, we recognize that relocating can be a challenging experience for employees. We wanted to ensure that our employees' well-being and satisfaction were prioritized during the process. To help ease the burden of relocation, Miratech provided financial assistance for transportation, temporary housing, and other expenses associated with finding a new home. This support ensured that our employees had a smooth transition to their new location, both within Ukraine and further afield for those who were eligible to leave the country.

Relocating can also have an emotional and psychological impact on employees, and we wanted to provide them with resources to help them navigate those challenges. That's why we created a Knowledge Library with psychology books and mental health tips to support those who were struggling with the stress of moving. These resources helped alleviate some of the anxiety and uncertainty associated with the relocation process. We also took proactive measures to ensure that our employees were safe and well taken care of throughout the relocation process. This included collecting data about employee locations and possible emergency requests daily until July 2022. By knowing the location of our employees, we could respond quickly to any emergencies and ensure their safety. To keep our employees informed about any changes or developments during the relocation process, we created internal communication channels with regular updates. This helped our employees feel more connected to the company and provided them with a sense of security during a time of change.



II. MIRAHELP | EMPLOYEES SUPPORT PROGRAM

April 2022

At Miratech, we understand the importance of supporting our employees in every aspect of their lives. This includes providing information and resources to navigate challenges that may arise from mandatory military service requirements. To show our support, we hosted an internal webinar featuring a lawyer with expertise in this area who provided valuable insights and guidance to alleviate some of the stress and uncertainty that can arise from this situation.

Similarly, understanding the complexities of tax systems is important for any business operating in Europe. To assist our employees, we held a webinar on this topic, which covered a range of helpful information such as an overview of tax regulations in different countries, tax planning strategies, and optimization techniques. By providing access to this knowledge and tools, we aim to support our employees in their roles and new locations. At Miratech, we also recognize the importance of supporting employees' families during times of war or conflict. To address this, we organized a webinar focused on how to support children during the war with child psychologists providing valuable information and resources for parents. Topics covered included common reactions children may have to war, tips for talking to children about war, and strategies for promoting resilience and coping skills. We aimed to provide our employees and their families with the tools to navigate these challenging situations. In all our efforts, we are committed to the well-being of our employees and their families, and to ensuring that they are well-equipped to navigate any situation that may arise.



May 2022

We are pleased to share that our colleague, Senior Software Engineer, Maksym Liubarets, and his wife have purchased and delivered thermal telescopes, radio stations, thermal imaging devices, and other essential equipment for Ukrainian soldiers. These contributions are making a significant impact in saving lives and bringing victory closer. We are also proud of our colleague from Finance, Valeriia Holoshchapova, who is a paramedic and has committed herself to military service. She is actively serving the Ukrainian army and volunteering in Poland. In addition, Valeriia is offering her support to our colleagues who are mobilized and is available to help them with obtaining body armor for their protection.

To support our military service members, while also preserving workplace stability, we have updated our internal policies for Military service with 'saving workplace'. We believe that these policies will help us to better support our colleagues who are serving their country, while also ensuring that the business can continue to operate effectively. We remain committed to upholding our social responsibilities and supporting our colleagues in all their endeavors.

June 2022

As part of its commitment to Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR), we have undertaken various activities to support its employees and the wider community. One such activity involved inviting lawyers to provide support and consulting on legalization and tax residence in the EU for the employees. This internal webinar was organized to help employees better understand the legal and tax requirements of living and working in the EU. Additionally, the lawyers offered constant consulting services to the employees to address any questions or concerns that may arise.

Another initiative undertaken by Miratech was the organization of webinars on relocation in Poland and Cyprus. These webinars were conducted by the company's Travel, Employee Experience, Staff Administration, and Finance teams to help employees with the transition. The webinars guided various aspects of relocation, such as housing, transportation, and other practical considerations.



Kseniya Belous, a Program Manager at Miratech, revealed a method for acquiring a drone for the Ukrainian army, as per her recent disclosure. This initiative was a testament to the company's commitment to supporting military and national security. Miratech recognized all contributors for their efforts in helping to acquire the drone, which is an essential tool for the Ukrainian army. Finally, Senior Vice-President, Corporate Services Executive Committee, Olga Skydan, expressed her admiration for all Miratech employees who contributed to buying CAT tourniquets for Ukrainian defenders. The tourniquets were sent to the unit where their colleague Vladyslav Yarmoliuk is serving. We are proud to have such dedicated employees on our team. This initiative is a testament to Miratech's commitment to supporting the community and its employees.

Miratech's NFT charity auction "Peace in Kids' Eyes"

Becoming a parent means taking on a tremendous amount of responsibility. As our joy grows, so do our worries. Our priority is to ensure our children grow up happy, healthy, and safe, but unfortunately, not all children have access to such privileges. This year, Ukrainian children have been exposed to many new dangers, including the risk of crossing borders alone, with only basic personal information written on their backs in a desperate attempt to find safety. Peace in Kids' Eyes initiative aims to support Ukrainian children who have been affected by the ongoing Russian War in Ukraine. In particular, the initiative is raising funds for the Children of a Heroes charity foundation, which helps children who have lost one or both parents as a result of the war.

To raise funds for this cause, we invited children to submit their art creations to a charity auction that was hosted on the opensea.io NFT platform. The auction launched on June 13 and ran for two weeks. For each artwork submitted by a child, Miratech donated \$10 to the Children of Heroes charity foundation. Interested individuals could bid on the pieces they would like to purchase, no matter their location. All the money raised from the auction was donated to the Children of Heroes charity foundation. The initiative raised awareness and funds to support the well-being and safety of Ukrainian children who have been impacted by the ongoing conflict in the region. By participating in this initiative, children could play an active role in supporting their peers and helping to make a difference in their lives.





July 2022

Miratech colleagues Andrii Kozlovskyi, Andrey Nosalskiy, Dmitriy Belous, Ihor Buherchuk, Mykhailo Bench, Oksana Krutybich, Oleg Sergeev, Olga Mamashvili, Olga Ryzhkova, Olga Skydan, and Sergey Simonchuk, Oleksandr Chubatiuk have demonstrated their commitment to supporting the Ukrainian military by providing tourniquets to our defenders. This equipment is used to equip individual first-aid kits for combatants who perform tasks at the front lines. Their efforts not only provide essential medical support to those in harm's way but also demonstrate the power of individual action to make a difference. In addition, to the contributions of our colleagues, our clients have also stepped up to support our defenders. Donating laptops to the Ukrainian army, with contributions from various departments including the IT department, Employee Experience, FSS, Finance, PMO, Accounting, and other people outside Miratech. The support of these people and organizations not only provides our defenders with critical resources but also shows the value of public-private partnerships in strengthening national security. Finally, we at Miratech have also made our contribution to the cause. We donated Starlink, a satellite internet service, that provides aid to members of the Ukrainian armed forces. By providing this technology, we hope to help our defenders stay connected and access critical information, no matter where they are stationed. This effort reflects our commitment to supporting the Ukrainian military and promoting greater security for all.

August 2022

Miratech has taken the initiative to become a Founding Sponsor of the Ukraine House DC Foundation, a non-partisan non-profit organization based in Washington DC, in collaboration with the Embassy of Ukraine in the USA. The Ukraine House Foundation aims to support Ukraine by donating, investing, sharing, communicating, and advocating for the country's interests. As a Founding Trustee of the Ukraine House, Miratech has been actively involved in promoting the organization's core mission and engaging with the US and international business communities. Miratech has also provided support for educational and informational events and worked with the leadership team to develop strategies for fulfilling the organization's goals. The Ukraine House Foundation was officially opened on September 1, 2021, by the President of Ukraine Volodymyr Zelenskyy, and the official Ukrainian delegation during the Presidential to visit Washington DC. In its first year, the organization hosted over 50 events and welcomed over 5,000 guests and visitors. In just three months after Russia invaded Ukraine on February 24, the Ukraine House Foundation collected \$5 million for United 24, a platform launched by the President of Ukraine as the main venue for collecting charitable donations in support of Ukraine.

Miratech's CEO, Valeriy Kutsyy, serves as a member of the Founding Sponsor Trustee Honorary Board and expressed enthusiasm for supporting the Ukraine House in Washington DC, stating, "The time for all businesses to support Ukraine has never been more right." The Director of the Ukraine House DC, Marianna Falkova, also acknowledged Miratech's support, saying, "Ukraine House is proud to have such a modern, high-tech, and innovative partner as Miratech." Ukrainian Ambassador to the U.S. Oksana Markarova at Ukraine House noted:

By raising funds for his family, we hope to alleviate some of the financial challenges that they may be experiencing during his absence. Volunteering is a selfless act that not only benefits those in need but also provides a sense of fulfillment and purpose to the volunteer. The donated funds will be used to support Ukraine's defense efforts and ensure that the Ukrainian Armed Forces have the resources they need to protect their nation.

Earlier this year, Miratech completed several other initiatives and donations to support the people of Ukraine. As responsible corporate citizens, we are committed to doing our part to help strengthen and protect the communities where we live and work.



IV. MIRATECH AGAINST BLACKOUTS

This winter, Ukraine has faced a significant challenge — power outages imposed by the government aimed at easing the strain on the grid, which has been severely damaged in the aftermath of the Russian missile and drone attacks. As a result, in Ukraine, many have to live in a situation of regular power outages. With that in mind, we at Miratech are obliged to do everything we can to ensure our teams can continue supporting our clients' projects. We turned our Ukrainian offices (Kyiv, Vinnytsia) into autonomous hubs to overcome the challenge of power outages and even the (unlikely) scenario of a total blackout. To ensure that Miratech's employees can continue to work productively during blackouts in Ukraine, we took several actions, including:

Providing backup power: At the company offices, we have backup generators and uninterruptible power supplies (UPS) that can provide power to critical systems and infrastructure during blackouts. This helps ensure that employees can continue to work without disruption.

Starlink: Satellite Internet is crucial for Ukraine at this time, providing an Internet connection when mobile communication systems or internet cables are damaged or destroyed. Starlink is a key strength, providing our offices with a stable Internet connection during blackouts. Combine Starlink with other sources of continuous access to the Internet, for example, signing up with multiple Internet providers and ones that offer powerful fiber-optic Internet. Thus, the combination of autonomous power generators and uninterrupted Internet access guarantee that offices can function stably for long periods without electricity.

Remote work: We allow our employees to work remotely during blackouts, if possible. This is facilitated through tools such as virtual private networks (VPNs), collaboration software, and video conferencing.

Ensuring data security: During blackouts, we take extra precautions to ensure the security of our employees' data and systems. This includes backing up critical data and ensuring that all security protocols are in place and functioning properly.

Providing support: We also provide additional support to Miratech's employees during blackouts, such as providing access to charging stations for mobile devices. Such devices power Wi-Fi routers, so they can work autonomously at home for more than 24 hours. We also offer flexible work hours to accommodate the blackout schedule.

Communication: It is crucial to have a clear communication plan in place during blackouts to keep our employees informed about the situation and any relevant updates. This helps alleviate stress and confusion among employees and ensures that everyone is on the same page.

By taking these actions, we have enabled our employees to continue to work productively during blackouts in Ukraine, which helps minimize the impact of the outage on their operations, performance, and customers

IV. MIRATECH AGAINST BLACKOUTS

New Safety Hub

We have launched a new Safety Hub in Kyiv too, for continuous service delivery. This space could be considered as an alternative to our main office building in the city, with some additional advantages. For example, it is more comfortable during power and heating outages, with the following things in place:

- Office furniture pre-equipped for over 30 workplaces and the possibility to increase to up to 60 workplaces
- MFP (printer, scanner, copy machine)
- An autonomous computer network for ease of work access (Internet Service Provider with optical line, plus Starlink)
- A generator providing an uninterrupted power supply (with fuel reserves for three working days in case of full power interruption)
- An autonomous heating system based on a solid-fired boiler (this can work with a generator too) to ensure comfortable working temperatures can be maintained (20+ Celsius)
- A fully equipped kitchen where hot and cold food and drinks can be prepared and stored
- Dedicated toilet
- Parking for five cars with security staff
- Sensor security monitoring, like we have in the main office

V. IT EDUCATION - MIRATECH INVESTS IN FUTURE TECHNOLOGY TALENT

Technology is all around us, and it's constantly evolving. From our smartphones to our homes, we rely on technology for almost everything we do. That's why learning about Information Technology (IT) is so important. We offer free training in software development, quality assurance, and business analysis to students and recent graduates. Miratech partners with VNTU (Vinnytsia National Technical University) to provide internships, mentorship, and job opportunities for students.

This partnership has had a big impact on the tech industry in Ukraine. By working closely with VNTU, Miratech is helping to bridge the gap between the academic and business communities. We are giving students the chance to learn from experienced professionals and get hands-on experience with the latest technologies. This is helping to build a pipeline of skilled professionals not just for our company, but for the whole industry. It's exciting to give young people the skills and opportunities to help them succeed and build a better future for all of us.

V. IT EDUCATION - MIRATECH INVESTS IN FUTURE TECHNOLOGY TALENT

IT Kids Club 2022, partnering with VNTU (Vinnytsia National Technical University)

IT Kids Club is a popular project, based in Ukraine, that helps children learn about technology. The goal is to develop their interest in digital literacy, so they can build on this introduction and succeed in the future.

The project started in 2019 and offers free classes to kids between 6 and 14 years old. Miratech employees volunteer their time to teach classes in web programming languages and robotics. They set up a special lab with all the equipment needed for the kids to learn, supported by some great mentors.

Even though the pandemic made getting together physically tricky, the classes moved online, so that we could continue to teach kids about cool things like Arduino robots, 3D printing, and web programming. Our employees also trained the mentors to teach new technologies too. And now, with the advantages of being virtual, the program has been expanded to reach children in two more countries.

IT Kids Club is an educational resource for kids who want to learn about IT. You can find free courses on YouTube that cover programming, robotics, game development, and artificial intelligence. By offering this program Miratech is helping kids become more creative, solve problems, and learn about the diverse opportunities in the tech industry. We are investing in the next generation of IT professionals who can, in turn, make a positive contribution to the future of the tech industry.
